

# Greenbank Club Coach



## Background

Greenbank FC has grown from 15 teams to 34 teams over the last 6 seasons and continue to grow each season. This is in large part due to the success of our Greenbank Kickers sessions for ages 4 - 6 and teams set-up each season from these sessions.

To enable the club to continue to grow, the committee are seeking applications for a Club Coach, who'll oversee these Kickers sessions and the development of new teams.

This will initially be for an average of 10 hours per month and the successful candidate has the opportunity to grow the role. The rate of pay will be determined by level of qualification and experience.

The successful applicant will be engaged under a fixed term contract for services on a self-employed basis. This will be an initial 12 month contract, starting 7<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

## Process

Interested parties are to submit their CV on no more than 2 sheets of A4 paper to Greenbank FC by Sunday 9th August, [greenbankfc@aol.co.uk](mailto:greenbankfc@aol.co.uk). CV's should include qualifications and experiences pertinent to the role.

A handover will be completed with the current Kickers coach who leads the weekly sessions.

## Candidate

The successful candidate must share the clubs values and philosophy, and be available on Tuesday evenings between 17:30 - 19:30 each week as a minimum.

## Job Description

Reporting to the club committee the post will require the successful candidate to:

- Plan and lead weekly Kickers sessions and support volunteers who help run the sessions.
- Look after all equipment and ensure this is brought to weekly sessions.
- Collect weekly subs and pay in at club meetings with completed register.
- Maintain communication with all players around club activities and sessions.
- Run four weekend 3 v 3 festivals throughout the year for Greenbank Kickers players.
- Set-up new teams and where possible attend the first two sessions to support new coaches to get up and running,
- Attend the greenbank committee meetings once every other month on a Monday evening.
- Share session ideas with other club coaches and post on our social media pages.
- Attend the club presentation evening to present Kickers players annual momentos.
- Make and manage booking of facilities for all sessions and activities related to the role.
- Support our annual fundraising events including the annual tournament.

With the support of the club there is the opportunity for the successful candidate to grow our recreational junior football offer with weekly sessions for other age groups, girls only sessions and holiday camps, amongst other areas.

You may also be asked to support training sessions by other Greenbank teams where they agree to pay for this additional time.
